Dear praying friends and supporting churches,

We are thanking the Lord for His protection over our homes and the Frontier Baptist Missions headquarters and seminary facilities during Hurricane Hannah. Thankfully the flood waters did not enter our primary buildings—only a shed and an old storage building, causing minimal damage.

Our new semester at Trinity Baptist Seminary is off to a good start. Now that we are offering classes in English as well as Spanish, our student body is roughly half English/half Spanish, with quite a few being bilingual. We have two local pastors among the student body. The week before the new semester started we offered a 4-day modular class for which local pastors were invited to come and bring their people for a class on personal evangelism and discipleship. We averaged about 50 each evening, with around 60 that came at least one evening of the class.

We have been in contact with some Cuban pastors during the pandemic. They are enduring many hardships and food shortages. Because of crippling restrictions due to the virus imposed on foreigners traveling to Cuba, I do not anticipate a trip until next year. Brother Ellison and I have some trips pending to other destinations overseas to help start Bible colleges when it is safer to travel.

I recently began having Bible studies with a young man who is a fairly new Christian. He is of a professional business background, so he surprised me at one point when he stated, "I don't want to make money, I just want to serve God!" He is now among the 27 taking classes at our seminary. Please pray for Dave, that God will guide him and provide direction in his life.

Thank you for praying for Pastor Yontz' health, the pastor of a local church where we attend and serve. Now that he is back in the pulpit I am once again available to preach in area churches. The last two Sundays I was asked to preach at a Spanish congregation where the pastor was under quarantine due to some of his family members being diagnosed with COVID. Next month I will be preaching at a Spanish church near Dallas.
