Dear praying friends and supporting churches,

We had another good semester at the seminary, which allowed us to finish the year strong. We added another hour of teaching in English to match our Spanish schedule. Another local pastor has been added to our all-volunteer teaching staff. More extensions are starting, therefore we decided to record instructional videos on how to initiate an extension, maintain records, how to grade, etc. This now enables us to cut down on time spent on training extension directors over video conference calls.

Shortly before Christmas we crossed the border into Mexico with a van loaded with literature, gospel tracts, used clothing and gift bags for children. Missionary Gary Ellison preached an anniversary service for a church started by a Frontier Baptist Missions missionary 34 years ago. The church is now pastored by a man who grew up in the church.

Frontier Baptist Missions now has 57 missionary families in 17 countries. We generally don't schedule interviews between Thanksgiving and New Years in order to give our board members a break, but this means we have a backlog of missionaries waiting to be interviewed. Most of them are Hispanic, and it is wonderful to see how God is calling and using them to join others in fulfilling the command "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15).

Since our last prayer letter my dear wife Jennifer was diagnosed with breast cancer. The good news—for which we thank the Lord—is that it was believed to have been discovered at an early stage. She underwent surgery on the 29th of December. We are waiting to hear the biopsy results since the surgery. She is to start a 6-week radiation treatment soon. My wife has been assigned to my same oncologist. I have been tested regularly since my cancer surgery four years ago, and we are thankful to report that I continue to be cancer-free. Thank you for your prayers.
