Dear praying friends and supporting churches:

We've had a busy summer, starting with the High School graduation of our youngest daughter. I spoke in a conference alongside others in a Spanish-speaking church in California, in which God moved in a special way. The last service started at 6:00 and didn't dismiss until 10:30 because of how God was working and the many decisions during the invitation. I also preached in several churches in our area alongside the Mexican border, while serving a minimum of three days a week at the office of Frontier Baptist Missions.

Our seminary classes resume towards the end of this month. We are interviewing pastors online before they are approved to be an official extension/satellite school. Currently by the grace of God, we have 38 extensions in 15 countries.

There is a testimony from a trip to Mexico in March which I did not have space to share in the previous prayer letter. One evening before dark the assistant pastor and I headed out to witness. We went to a plaza where I found five teenagers sitting together. I gave them each a gospel tract and began to share the plan of salvation. Being a group setting, I was half-expecting one or more to act bored, or start ribbing the others, or be a distraction somehow. To my surprise, they followed along attentively, and traced their fingers across the verses that I was reading aloud from the gospel tract. I took about 20 minutes to not rush them, and after allowing questions and ensuring they seemed to understand, all five teenagers bowed their head and prayed, accepting the Lord as their Saviour. The fields truly are white ready to harvest (John 4:35).

The trip to Venezuela has been postponed. The church we will be with has been involved in providing food and bottled water as well as witnessing to the survivors of the recent earthquake that caused serious devastation and loss of life to a part of the country.
